WILLIAMSON-SODUS (SDC) AIRPORT, WILLIAMSON, NY***

*Come and enjoy the camaraderie of your fellow pilots. Share laughter,
networking and lots of hangar flying. There will be good food, comfortable
accommodations, fun programs and a chance to enjoy the company of fellow 99s.*

Guests are certainly welcome, so bring your 49 ½.

The towns of Williamson and Sodus are located just south of Lake Ontario, in the Finger Lakes region of New York. Fall is a wonderful time to visit with the foliage at or near peak during the 2nd and 3rd weeks of October. If arriving by car, may we suggest you travel by interstate part way and shift to a rural road to enjoy the scenery on your way to Webster, NY, where the hotel is located. Route 104 is a popular "leaf peeping" route.

The Holiday Inn Express is located at 960 Holt Road, Webster, NY. Make your hotel reservation by calling the Holiday Inn Express at 585-872-0900 or 888-465-4329 or online at www.hiexpress.com/websterny. If calling the hotel, be sure to identify yourself as a member of the NY/NJ 99 Section. If booking online, after entering the dates, type in the Group Code, NYJ, to book. Double queen room or king room is \$99.00 plus 14% tax. A hot breakfast is included with your stay. Guests have until 6pm on the arrival date to cancel the reservation without a charge. All room reservations made to prior to October 2, 2009 are eligible for this reduced price.

The landing and tie-down fees at the Rochester airport are steep. You are welcome to fly in to Williamson-Sodus (SDC) airport with no fees. Contact Frances Englund at 585-899-0487 for parking instructions and ETA before arrival at KSDC.

Transportation to the hotel will be provided by Chapter members. If you are on a commercial flight into Rochester, or you prefer to fly GA into Rochester, please call the Holiday Inn Express for the free airport shuttle they provide.

At the hotel, the registration table will be located on the first floor in the Breakfast area and will be staffed after 4:30 PM on Friday. A light meal will be served in the Breakfast area from 6:00 to 9:00 PM. Please join us and help us get to know you by sharing your love of flying and your experiences with the 99s! Bring a swim suit to swim in the pool or relax in the whirlpool.

The owners of Young Sommer Winery have invited the NY-NJ 99s to join them Friday evening for a wine tasting. Wilma and Herman Sommer opened this winery in the spring of 2008. They specialize in various fruit wines as well as traditional grape wines. The winery is about a 15 minute drive from the hotel at 4287 Jersey Road, Williamson, NY. Here's a link to their

website: <http://www.yswinery.com>. Transportation will be provided for those people who wish to visit the winery. We will leave the hotel about 5:30 PM and return to the hotel around 8:00 PM.

Wake up to a hot breakfast served by the hotel. For people staying at the hotel, the breakfast is complimentary. If you are local or plan to drive in and join us for breakfast, the charge is \$9.95 plus tax and tip payable at breakfast.

We have several fun and interesting activities planned for Saturday morning after breakfast. It is suggested that you check out of the hotel before leaving on the morning activities. The staff at the Rochester control tower and TRACON offered to host us for a tour of their facilities. More importantly, they want to open a window into what their jobs entail and how we can be better aviation partners. For those who have “been there and done that”, a docent led tour of the Sodus Bay Lighthouse Museum overlooking the southern shores of Lake Ontario is available. The view is beautiful! More information is available at <http://www.soduspointlighthouse.org>. Wear your walking shoes. On the way back to SDC from the lighthouse, we will stop at the Helluva Good Cheese Store. Some people say this little country store is a hidden treasure. You will find everything from locally made sauces, pickles and fudge to the Helluva Good brand cheeses and dips. Coolers will be available at SDC to store items needing refrigeration. We encourage you to be prepared to refrigerate your treasures for your trip home. After the tours are over, we will go straight to Williamson-Sodus airport for lunch and our business meeting.

Lunch will be served as close to noon as we can. A local barbeque restaurant, “Bad to the Bone”, is catering our lunch. Entrees included are barbeque chicken, pulled pork or ribs with sides, dessert and beverages. **Please notify us as soon as possible if you have any special dietary needs or restrictions.**

After lunch, guests of the 99s may choose to tour the George Eastman House and Museum in Rochester. George Eastman was the founder of Eastman Kodak and a major local philanthropist. Transportation will be provided for those who need it. We will leave SDC right after lunch for the 40 minute ride to the George Eastman House. A tour of the house is scheduled for 2:00 PM. Unfortunately; we need to leave the museum/house by 3:30 PM to be back to the airport shortly after 4:00 PM. For 99s and those guests who choose to not go to the Eastman House, we are offering a one hour Wings Seminar led by FAA Aviation Safety Counselor, Gene Benson. The seminar will begin immediately following lunch, and will count for one credit Knowledge, Elective, Basic (KEB). The title of the seminar is “Having a Procedure Without Anesthetic”.
